1. **All/Every** – {pas}[G3956]<5>(J17:2, 7, 10, 21) means the totality or the whole of a group, concept, or collective body.
2. **And** – {kai}[G2532]<60+>(Throughout) means the primary conjunction used to connect thoughts and join distinct ideas together.
3. **As/Even as** – {kathōs}[G2531]<8>(J17:2, 11, 14, 16, 18, 21, 22, 23) means a standard of likeness or a direct comparison between two distinct things or actions.
4. **Behold** – {theōreō}[G2334]<1>(J17:24) means to look at something with sustained attention, often leading to a deeper spiritual understanding.
5. **Believe** – {pisteuō}[G4100]<3>(J17:8, 20, 21) means the act of placing one's total trust, confidence, and reliance in a person or a message.
6. **Before** – {pro}[G4253]<2>(J17:5, 24) means a position in time or space that precedes another specific event, object, or person.
7. **But** – {alla}[G235]<4>(J17:9, 13, 15, 20) means a conjunction used to mark a strong and definitive contrast between two opposing ideas.
8. **Come** – {erchomai}[G2064]<2>(J17:11, 13) means the act of moving toward a specific destination or arriving at an appointed place.
9. **Complete/Perfect** – {teleioō}[G5048]<2>(J17:4, 23) means to bring a task or a relationship to its intended goal, maturity, or state of total fulfillment.
10. **Concerning** – {peri}[G4012]<4>(J17:9, 20) means the preposition used to introduce the specific subject or person that a statement is regarding.
11. **Eternal** – {aiōnios}[G166]<3>(J17:2, 3) means a quality of existence that belongs to the age of God and is without beginning or end.
12. **Evil** – {ponēros}[G4190]<1>(J17:15) means that which is morally corrupt, harmful, or under the active influence of the devil.
13. **Father** – {patēr}[G3962]<6>(J17:1, 5, 11, 21, 24, 25) means the ultimate source of life and the intimate title for the first person of the Trinity.
14. **For/On behalf of** – {hyper}[G5228]<1>(J17:19) means an action that is performed for the sake of, or in the place of, another person.
15. **Foundation** – {katabolē}[G2602]<1>(J17:24) means the beginning, the inception, or the act of laying down the groundwork for the universe.
16. **Fulfill** – {plēroō}[G4137]<2>(J17:12, 13) means to make something entirely full or to bring a divine purpose to its total accomplishment.
17. **Give/Given** – {didōmi}[G1325]<17>(J17:2, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 14, 22, 24) means the act of granting, bestowing, or entrusting something of value to another.
18. **Glorify** – {doxazō}[G1392]<5>(J17:1, 4, 5, 10) means the action of revealing, magnifying, or making visible the true excellence and honor of someone.

19. **Glory** – {doxa}[G1391]<3>(J17:5, 22, 24) means the manifest honor, divine splendor, and the essential weight of God’s character.
20. **Guard** – {phylassō}[G5442]<1>(J17:12) means to keep a watchful eye over or protect a person from external harm or loss.
21. **Holy** – {hagios}[G40]<1>(J17:11) means that which is sacred, morally pure, and completely set apart from the common or the profane.
22. **Hour** – {hōra}[G5610]<1>(J17:1) means a specific, appointed time or a highly significant season within God’s redemptive plan.
23. **I/Me** – {egō}[G1473]<50+>(Throughout) means the first-person pronouns used by Jesus to identify Himself as the active speaker and mediator.
24. **In** – {en}[G1722]<14>(J17:10, 11, 12, 13, 19, 21, 23, 26) means a state of being located within a specific place, person, condition, or relationship.
25. **Into/To** – {eis}[G1519]<7>(J17:1, 18, 20, 23) means a preposition indicating motion toward the interior of something or toward a specific intended goal.
26. **Joy** – {chara}[G5479]<1>(J17:13) means a state of deep, supernatural gladness and spiritual well-being that comes from God.
27. **Keep** – {tēreō}[G5083]<5>(J17:6, 11, 12, 15) means to guard, preserve, or hold fast to something so that it remains secure and unchanged.
28. **Know** – {ginōskō}[G1097]<7>(J17:3, 7, 8, 23, 25) means to have an experiential, personal, and relational understanding of someone rather than mere facts.
29. **Life** – {zōē}[G2222]<3>(J17:2, 3) means the essential principle of existence, specifically the spiritual and eternal life found only in God.
30. **Love (Noun)** – {agapē}[G26]<1>(J17:26) means the state of unconditional, sacrificial, and divine love that characterizes God’s nature.
31. **Love (Verb)** – {agapaō}[G25]<5>(J17:23, 24, 26) means to exercise a selfless, sacrificial, and covenantal commitment toward another person.
32. **Make Known** – {gnōrizō}[G1107]<2>(J17:26) means the act of communicating or revealing information so that others may understand it clearly.
33. **Name** – {onoma}[G3686]<4>(J17:6, 11, 12, 26) means the reputation, authority, and the totality of the character belonging to a person.
34. **Now** – {nyn}[G3568]<5>(J17:5, 7, 11, 13) means the adverb that identifies the present moment in time or the current state of spiritual affairs.
35. **One** – {hen}[G1520]<5>(J17:11, 21, 22, 23) means a state of perfect unity or being a single, undivided, and harmonious whole.
36. **Only** – {monos}[G3441]<2>(J17:3, 20) means being unique, solitary, or the only instance of its kind in existence.

37. **Out of/From** – {ek}[G1537]<8>(J17:6, 12, 14, 15, 16) means the origin, the source, or the point of departure for a person or a concept.
38. **Perish** – {apollymi}[G622]<1>(J17:12) means the process of being lost, destroyed, or coming to a state of eternal ruin.
39. **Receive** – {lambanō}[G2983]<1>(J17:8) means the act of taking hold of or accepting a gift or message that has been offered.
40. **Reveal/Manifest** – {phanerōō}[G5319]<1>(J17:6) means to make something clearly visible or known that was previously concealed or hidden.
41. **Righteous** – {dikaios}[G1342]<1>(J17:25) means a person or action that is in total, perfect alignment with God's moral standards.
42. **Sanctify** – {hagiazō}[G37]<3>(J17:17, 19) means to set someone or something apart from common use for a holy and dedicated purpose.
43. **Scripture** – {graphē}[G1124]<1>(J17:12) means the sacred, authoritative writings that contain God's revealed truth and promises.
44. **Sent** – {apostellō}[G649]<7>(J17:3, 8, 18, 21, 23, 25) means to be dispatched with a specific commission and the sender's full authority.
45. **So that/That** – {hina}[G2443]<19>(J17:1, 2, 3, 4, 11, 13, 15, 19, 21, 22, 23, 24, 26) means a conjunction introducing the purpose, intent, or intended result of an action.
46. **Son** – {huios}[G5207]<3>(J17:1, 12) means the second person of the Trinity or one who stands in a position of inheritance.
47. **Speak** – {laleō}[G2980]<2>(J17:1, 13) means the act of vocalizing thoughts or communicating a message through the use of speech.
48. **That/Because** – {hoti}[G3754]<13>(J17:7, 8, 9, 14, 21, 23, 24, 25) means the conjunction that identifies the reason for an action or introduces a factual statement.
49. **The** – {ho}[G3588]<50+>(Throughout) means the definite article used to distinguish and point out specific people, objects, or concepts.
50. **Them** – {autos}[G846]<30+>(Throughout) means the third-person pronoun referring back to the disciples or the community of believers.
51. **This/These** – {houtos}[G3778]<4>(J17:1, 3, 13, 20) means the demonstrative pronoun pointing specifically to things that are near or recently mentioned.
52. **Through** – {dia}[G1223]<1>(J17:20) means the preposition that identifies the specific means or the agency through which an action occurs.
53. **To Be/Am** – {eimi}[G1510]<18>(J17:3, 5, 7, 9, 10, 11, 14, 16, 21, 24) means the fundamental verb of existence used to define identity or a current state of being.
54. **Toward** – {pros}[G4314]<2>(J17:11, 13) means a preposition signifying a relational direction or movement toward a specific person or object.
55. **Truth** – {alētheia}[G225]<3>(J17:17, 19) means reality as it is defined by God's character and as it is revealed in His Word.

56. **Which/Who** – {hos}[G3739]<13>(J17:4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 11, 12, 22, 24, 26) means the relative pronoun used to refer back to a previously named person or thing for further description.
57. **With** – {meta}[G3326]<2>(J17:12, 24) means a preposition indicating companionship, association, or being in the literal presence of someone.
58. **Word (Message)** – {logos}[G3056]<3>(J17:6, 14, 17) means a comprehensive divine message, a statement of truth, or the personified Word of God.
59. **Word (Utterance)** – {rhēma}[G4487]<1>(J17:8) means the specific, individual spoken words or utterances given by God to His people.
60. **Work/Task** – {ergon}[G2041]<1>(J17:4) means a specific deed, labor, or mission that has been assigned by God to be completed.
61. **World** – {kosmos}[G2889]<18>(J17:5, 6, 9, 11, 13, 14, 15, 16, 18, 21, 23, 24, 25) means the created order or the collective system of humanity often standing apart from God.
